SINGLETON NEIGHBOURHOOD CENTRE OPENDOOR

We were pleased to continue our support of Singleton Neighbourhood Centre's OpenDoor. The OpenDoor provides free meals, showers, laundry facilities, food pantry, clothing, and access to community services for those in need in Singleton and surrounds. Staffed mainly by volunteers, the OpenDoor provides a community safe space where people can get some of their basic needs met.

The Bloomfield Group Foundation has proudly funded the OpenDoor's Project Manager since July 2019.



LIFELINE HUNTER

Our Foundation is a proud supporter of Lifeline Hunter, providing funding so that Lifeline can continue to deliver phone counselling sessions and phone crisis support across the Hunter. Face-to-face counselling is also provided by Lifeline one day per week from Singleton Neighbourhood Centre.



SINGLETON POLICE CITIZENS YOUTH CLUB DRIVE PROGRAM

We were delighted to provide ongoing support to Singleton PCYC for their DRIVE program, which helps our local young people meet the requirements necessary to get their Motor Vehicle Licence.

The program includes volunteer mentors helping the candidates get 120 hours of driving experience, professional driving lessons, a Safe Driver course, and Hazard Perception tests. Since Bloomfield has come on board with Singleton PCYC, more than 30 young people have graduated from the DRIVE program with their Licence, opening up a range of future life and work opportunities for these young people.

We were able to meet and speak with hundreds of community members about our operations and work in the community, and we gave out complimentary fairy floss to all of the kids.
